Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for the County of Orange's Behavioral Health Families and Children's Campus project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of Orange, located at 333 W. Santa Ana Blvd, Santa Ana, CA 92701.

In January 2021, the County of Orange (County) opened its first payor agnostic mental health treatment campus, Be Well, in central Orange County. To date, its programs are at capacity. The demands for the programs demonstrate the need to provide mental health treatment regardless of payment source. The County plans to open two more Be Well campuses throughout Orange County – North and South – to ensure equitable access to mental health services for its residents. The first campus is located in the district at 265 S. Anita Drive, Orange, CA 92868. As the country re-opens following the countrywide shutdown from COVID-19, the mental health of Orange County's children is at the forefront of its residents' minds. The County if awarded \$5 million would allocate that money as follows: (1) \$3 million to Planning/Design (would show the quickest results). (2) \$2 million Construction.
