In January 2021, the County of Orange (County) opened its first payor agnostic mental health treatment campus, Be Well, in central Orange County. To date, its programs are at capacity. The County plans to open two more Be Well campuses throughout Orange County – North and South – to ensure equitable access to mental health services for its residents. The first campus is located in the district at 265 S. Anita Drive, Orange, CA 92868. The County if awarded \$5 million would allocate that money as follows: (1) \$3 million to Planning/Design (would show the quickest results). (2) \$2 million Construction.
